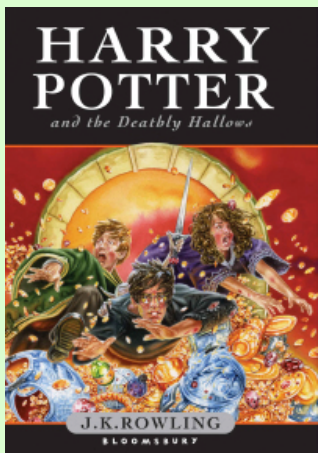
AWESOME AUTHOR J.K. ROWLING

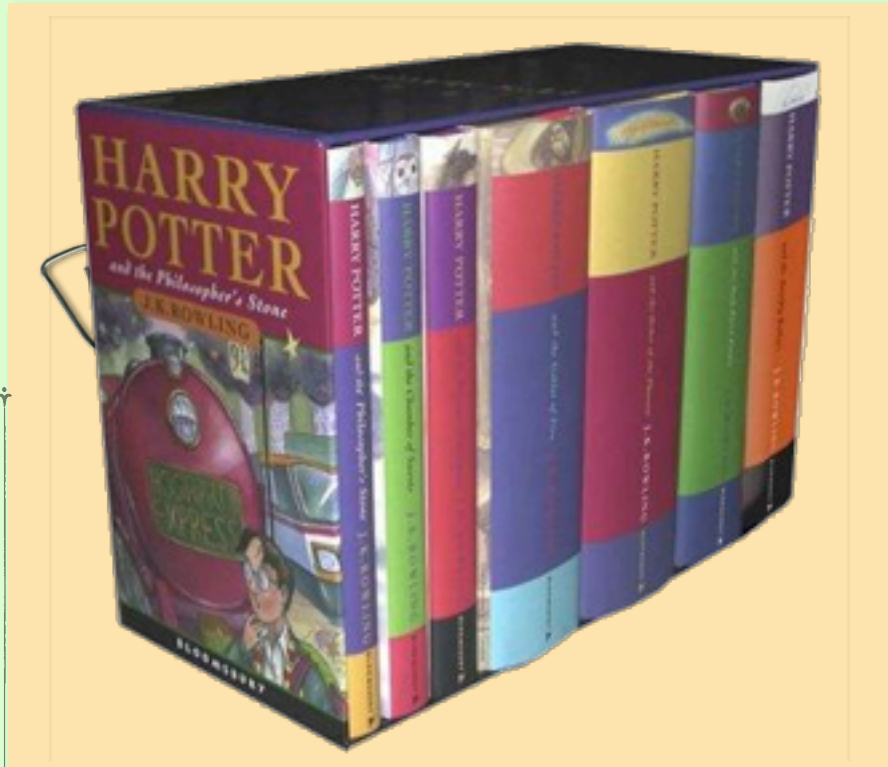


Harry Potter (Series)

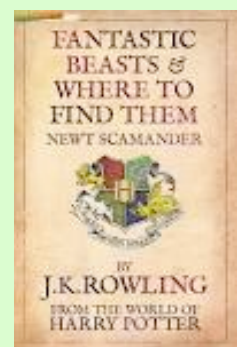
Rating system 1 = The worst book you have ever read. 10 = The best book you have ever read.
