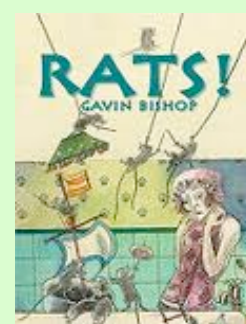
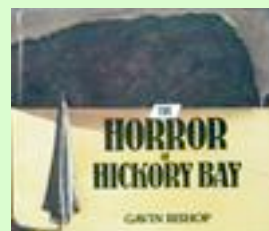
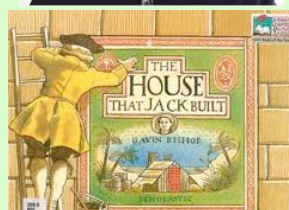
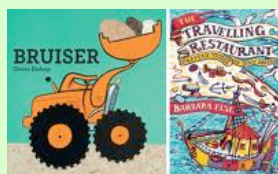


Rating system 1=The worst you have ever read. 10=The best book you have ever read. I rate this book, Kiwi Moon. 9/10
