All marks gained in formal assessments can be used by NZQA should a boy be unable to sit his NCEA exams and compassionate consideration is granted.

At the time of each report the progress of every boy is evaluated by the Dean. Those who are behind, lack motivation or are causing concern, are taken aside and the situation is discussed. If necessary the boy is put on daily or weekly report and parents are contacted.

There are a number of opportunities each year for parents to visit the school and discuss their son's progress with his teachers.
